

Brockville General Hospital (BGH) has an accredited digital Mammography department that offers screening, diagnostic, and Ontario Breast Screening Program (OBSP) appointments.

Breast Cancer starts small and will grow if unattended. BGH Technologists and Radiologists work hard to find these cancers before clients can feel them.

Women and men requiring mammograms need a requisition from their doctor or primary healthcare provider such as a Nurse Practitioner. The medical office will fax the requisition to the Mammography Department and BGH will call you with the appointment.

The OBSP program is for women age 50 to 74 who don't have current breast issues. You can call 613-345-8304 to book your own appointment. OBSP appointments are available Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

On the day of your Mammogram:

1. Do **NOT** wear scented products.
2. Do **NOT** use body powder, creams or deodorant on day of examination.
3. For your comfort, please wear a 2 piece outfit.
4. Arrive 15 minutes before your appointment time
5. Register at the Central Registration Desk at the main entrance of the hospital before going to the Mammography Department.

NOTE: If you are late for registering, you may be rescheduled for another date.

Exams are quick and usually take less than 15 minutes to complete.

The mammography exam includes firm compression of your breast. This may be uncomfortable and it is suggested that you have your mammogram between periods.

Sometimes clients need additional mammogram views or other tests after their mammogram is done. If the Radiologist requests this, we will call you to make the arrangements.
