Your Path to Progress

Our multidisciplinary team will work closely with patients, families, and caregivers to support recovery every step of the way. Services are tailored to the individual's needs and may include one or more of the following professions:

Occupational Therapy:

- Thinking and visual perceptual assessment / retraining
- Daily living skills
- Equipment recommendations and prescription
- Upper extremity function

Physiotherapy:

- Functional mobility and balance retraining
- Range of motion and strengthening
- Physical conditioning
- Recommendations for ongoing exercise at home or in the community

Speech-Language Pathology:

- Assessment and treatment
- Language (listening comprehension, verbal expression, reading or writing)
- Cognitive communication (memory, reasoning, problem solving, organizing)
- Swallowing

Social Work:

- Individual and family adjustment counselling
- Linkages with community resources
- Assistance with securing financial support

Community Stroke Rehabilitation Program

The Brockville General Hospital has collaborated with the Stroke Network of Southeastern Ontario to help bring Brockville's very own Community Stroke Rehabilitation Clinic to life. If you have had a stroke in the last 12 months, you may be eligible for the program. A doctor's referral is required. The program offers intensive Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, and Social Work services to support individuals in their recovery; each program is unique in its specificity to one's goals. Our program combines a mix of in clinic therapy, community therapy, and virtual therapy sessions. Our team and community partners will also provide you with the support and education needed to help manage life after stroke.
